

Did you know?

A typical barge is 195 feet long and 35 feet wide and can carry 1,500 tons. That's equal to 15 rail cars and 60 semis. Many of the tow boats you see go by have 15 barges attached. That equals 225 rail cars and 900 semis.



Did you know you can visit 3 states in a matter of minutes? A Place to Sew is in Wisconsin, directly across the river is Iowa and slightly north is Minnesota. If you cross the river in Lansing, Iowa, and go 12 miles north, you will be in Minnesota.

The Mississippi River is the third largest river in the world. This portion of the river is part of the Great Mississippi Flyaway, a migratory route for 40% of North America's waterfowl. Swans, pelicans, blue herons, egrets, warblers, orioles, all use the river corridor for the spring and fall migrations.



Highway 35 is part of the Great River Road, which has been dubbed one of the most scenic routes in mid-America. Of its 250 miles, one stretch runs right in front of the Cottage and Steamboat House. The river is on one side, the majestic bluffs on the other – a spectacular sight!

Because the houses are located part way up a bluff, we have fabulous views of the Mississippi River's main channel and majestic bluffs.
